



Sue Kruger Future Teacher Scholarship Application 2012

Who can apply?

Any member of the current Choctawhatchee High School senior class.

What are the qualifications?

1. Student must be planning to become a teacher in either a private or public school setting: elementary or secondary
2. The student must be accepted at a college or university and must declare education as a major, the first semester the scholarship is given.

How many scholarships will be given and for what amount?

One scholarship of \$500 will be given.

The scholarship is sent directly to the student's school, and NOT given directly to the student. Once the student has registered for at least one course in the education field, the funds will be sent. The scholarship funds will be used toward tuition, room and board, fees or books and supplies.

How will recipients be determined?

The scholarship's purpose is to encourage students to become educators. This scholarship is not based on the student's financial need, but rather, the student's educational goals. Academic information on the scholarship will indicate if a student is qualified to enter a college or university in the fall. Most importantly the panel will select the applicant(s) who best describe their desire or love of teaching.
